TEQUESTA, Fla. (Oct. 19, 2021) – For the seventh consecutive year, *Hannah's Home of South Florida* is bringing a pumpkin patch to the community to celebrate fall.

Families can enjoy pumpkins, photos and snacks from Oct. 20-30 between noon and 6 p.m. on the front lawns of Hannah's Home. A special family fun day featuring an ice cream truck, games and face painting will take place on Saturday, Oct. 23 from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m.

"I am so excited that the pumpkin patch is starting this week," said Betty Wolcott, operations coordinator for Hannah's Home. "This year, we added some fun games for the children to enjoy, so we hope to see lots of families come out on Oct. 23."

With direction from volunteer arts instructor, Marta Watts, resident mothers have made handicrafts that will be for sale at the pumpkin patch. New this year: Tie-dye onesies.

All proceeds from the event will go towards the mission of Hannah's Home, a non-profit organization providing a safe and loving environment for single, pregnant young women. Hannah's Home offers a two-year residential program that provides food, lodging, clothing and medical care.

Since its doors opened in 2011, nearly 65 infants have found a home at Hannah's Home. With a maximum capacity of eight women and their babies, Hannah's Home now is serving three resident mothers and their babies, with two babies on the way.
