Tequesta fire fighters spark interest in safety at Hannah's Home

TEQUESTA, Fla. (Apr. 14, 2022) – Fire fighters from the Tequesta Fire Department educated the resident mothers of Hannah's Home on fire safety protocols as part of the Home's life skills training program.

As part of a two-year residential program, Hannah's Home residents get the life skills they need to leave the Home and become independent members of society.

"It was very informative and a pleasure to meet the Tequesta Fire Department," said Jadyn, a Hannah's Home resident.

Every Friday morning, Hannah's Home residents attend life skills classes taught by volunteers from various professional backgrounds. The young mothers ages 18 to 25 learn about parenting, cooking, nutrition, budgeting, self-defense and career counseling.

Tequesta's fire fighters demonstrated how common household fires can start and walked attendees through the protocols and best practices for responding to such crises.

Jadyn said that it didn't hurt that the fire fighters arrived in yellow fire trucks.

"They said they were all out of red paint, so the next best was banana yellow," she said. "They were pretty funny."

Residents in the Hannah's Home program often bring with them histories of abuse and neglect, with many reporting the absence in their lives of any reliable parents or guardians.

The residential program at Hannah's Home also provides its residents with food, clothing and medical care. Since its doors opened in 2011, 70 infants have found a home at Hannah's Home. With a maximum capacity of eight women and their children, Hannah's Home is currently serving six resident mothers, with three infants on the way.
